n the deepest moment, with no little consideration; In the name and by the Authority of the Sheriff of this good region, I hereby commit to history, through this official instrument, the following;

Whereas: Precedent has been established through the ages, that the precursor of the ancient office of Sheriff, the King's Reeve, was empowered to make proclamations; and

Whereas: This precedent was reinforced when the first proclamation in the United States, The Declaration of Independence, was read to the public by Sheriff John Nixon; and

Whereas: Charles E. Nelson has donated five hundred dollars to the Mahoning County Sheriff's Department Drug Abuse Resistance Education (D.A.R.E.) Program on April 19, 1995;
